



## 4 Days Luang Prabang

### DAY 1 | VIENTIANE - LUANG PRABANG BY TRAIN [L]

09:30 Transfer to Vientiane Train Station and travel to Luang Prabang by Train, route C82 at 11:00.  
12:58. Upon arrival you will be picked up by private car and transferred to your restaurant to enjoy your lunch at a local restaurant.

Following lunch, continue to climb to the top of this sacred hill (Phousi) reveals sublime 360-degree panoramic views of the city, the Mekong River and surrounding lush jungle. A small Buddhist temple and a gold stupa are at the top, and its views naturally make this a popular sunset spot.

Then, transfer to your hotel for check in.

### DAY 02 | LUANG PRABANG – PAK OU CAVES BY TRADITIONAL BOAT [B, L]

09.00 After breakfast, we head to Wat Xieng Thong. Also known as the 'golden city temple', this 16th century complex sits close to the meeting of Luang Prabang's two rivers at the tip of the peninsula. Adorned in ornate colored glass, this sacred site is considered to be the town's most beautiful temple and it serves as a religious and national symbol. It was here that Laotian kings were crowned.

Next, continue to the pier to board a traditional boat and cruise upstream along the Mekong River to visit sacred Buddhist caves. We pass by sweeping rural landscapes and life being lived out on the banks, making a short stop on the way at the picturesque village of Thin Hong to get a glimpse into local life. We then continue to the sacred Tham Ting and Tham Phoum caves which house hundreds of Buddha statues. After our cave exploration, we jump back on the boat and enjoy lunch at local restaurant then we return to Luang Prabang, stopping at Ban Xang Khong, a village that specialises in handmade paper and then visit the TAEC ethnographic museum (closed Mondays).

This evening, we recommend taking a stroll through the Night Market. Down the street from the former palace, dozens of sellers display there both authentic Laotian crafts, such as woven silk, embroidered textiles, and silver jewelry, as well as made in-Chian offerings of Beer Lao T-shirts and knockoff cotton scarves. The serene atmosphere and beautiful goods make it one of the best places to buy souvenirs.

### DAY 03 | LUANG PRABANG – ALMS GIVING - KUANG SI WATERFALLS [B, L]

06.00 Start the day with a dose of spirituality and watch monks carry out the early-morning ritual of tak bat. This forms a daily part of Laotians' lives and sees monks collect offerings in return for a blessing. We then visit a fresh fruit market before returning to the hotel for breakfast.

Following breakfast, continue to visit the Royal Palace Museum to browse a treasure chest of ancient relics. We continue on foot to Wat Mai, a shrine adorned in black and red lacquer and gold leaf. *Please note that when visiting the National Museum in Luang Prabang, one should be dressed modestly (shoulders and legs must be covered).* Next, visit Wat Visoun. Originally built during the reign of King Wisunarat in 1512, the temple is Luang Prabang's oldest and its design is influenced by Thai-Lu architecture. The temple complex also features That Makmo, a watermelon-shaped stupa.

We set off on a scenic drive to one of Laos' top attractions, stunning Kuangsi Waterfall (32 km) and then take a short walk-through tropical forest to the impressive tiered falls which cascade into clear limestone pools. Don't forget your bathers to take a refreshing dip in one of the nearby pools, followed by a visit to the Asian Bear Sanctuary to learn about the plight of bears living in the area and efforts to safeguard them. We enjoy lunch at the falls before driving back to Luang Prabang.

Upon arrival in Vientiane you will be picked up by private car and transfer to the Vientiane city downtown.
